AUSA Hosts USA Pavilion at Eurosatory 2026

The Association of the U.S. Army is once again organizing the USA Security and Defense Pavilion at Eurosatory, the world’s largest defense and security exhibition.

This year’s event from June 15–19 in the Nord Villepinte Exhibition Center in Paris will feature the largest USA Pavilion to date, with 119 exhibitors covering more than 3,400 square meters.

“The Association of the U.S. Army is proud to present the USA Security and Defense Pavilion at Eurosatory,” said retired Brig. Gen. Jack Haley, AUSA’s vice president of Membership and Meetings. “This year’s pavilion is the largest we’ve ever had, and as AUSA has done every year since the 1990s, we look forward to bringing together industry from around the world with the U.S. Army and its international partners and allies.”

The USA Security and Defense Pavilion is one of 40 national pavilions at the 2026 exhibition. It is one of the largest and most sought-out country pavilions, showcasing cutting-edge innovations and advanced technologies developed by leading American defense companies.

An outdoor space adjacent to the indoor pavilion will feature U.S. Army equipment including the Patriot Missile System and the Infantry Squad Vehicle.

In all, more than 2,100 exhibitors from 65 countries will attend Eurosatory this year. Some of the technologies on display include drones, long-range surface-to-surface missile systems, anti-missile and anti-drone solutions, land vehicles, aircraft and watercraft, command-and-control and cybersecurity capabilities and all forms of equipment, weapons, ammunition and individual protection.

Throughout the week, AUSA also will host U.S. Army leaders at the USA Security and Defense Pavilion’s Speakers Corner. Featured speakers include Brent Ingraham, assistant Army secretary for acquisition, logistics and technology; Patrick Mason, deputy assistant secretary of the Army for defense exports and cooperation; and Kevin Marcus, deputy chief of staff of plans, G-5, for U.S. Army Europe and Africa. Also scheduled to speak is Michael Vacarro, acting principal deputy secretary of state for the bureau of political-military affairs.
