

## **I-SEE Group has launched I-SEE Asia, a franco-taiwanese industrial platform, designed to promote the deployment of the next generation of drones**

On Thursday 18 June 2026, as part of the 2026 edition of Eurosatory, I-SEE Group, a French company specializing in heavy long-range drones, announced the creation of I-SEE Asia, a joint venture based in Taiwan in partnership with Lung Hwa Electronics Co., Ltd. The aim of this strategic alliance is to establish an industrial and commercial platform in Asia to accelerate the regional and international deployment of drone technologies.

### **Industrial complementarity**

I-SEE Asia will create synergy between the complementary expertise of these two industry players. For I-SEE : its expertise in the design and integration of high-performance heavy-duty drones, designed for long-range endurance missions. And for Lung Hwa Electronics, a Taiwanese company : its specialization in maritime satellite communications, cybersecurity and video surveillance IoT, whilst providing strong industrial footprint and well-established commercial networks throughout the Asia-Pacific region.

### **A foothold in Asia**

Based in Taiwan, I-SEE Asia is designed to serve as I-SEE's primary gateway to Asian markets. The joint venture's core activities will encompass drone sales development across the region, the build-out of serial production capacity, and the establishment of industrial partnerships in the semiconductor sector — an area in which Taiwan holds a globally recognized leading position.

### **Extended partnership**

Beyond I-SEE's own operations, the joint venture has been structured as a shared industrial infrastructure. Partner companies working with I-SEE will have the option to leverage the Taiwanese industrial base for their own regional operations, benefiting from a structured entry point into one of the world's most strategically important markets.
