



# Windracers selected as key supplier in UK Government's biggest ever drone package for Ukraine

**London (UK) – 15 April 2026** – Windracers has been selected as one of three primary suppliers in the UK Government's largest ever drone support package for Ukraine.

Announced by Defence Secretary John Healey at the Ukraine Defence Contact Group in Berlin today, the landmark £752m package includes 120,000 drones and represents a significant step in strengthening Ukraine's operational capability, while reinforcing the UK's position as a leader in autonomous defence technologies.

Windracers inclusion as a core supplier highlights the growing role of autonomous heavy-lift long-range drones in modern defence and the importance of sovereign UK capability in delivering resilient, mission-ready platforms.

**Defence Secretary John Healey MP said:** "In the fifth year of Putin's brutal war, the UK is stepping up further and providing the highest ever number of drones for Ukraine this year. This big boost of battle-proven drones will give Ukrainian forces the capability they need to defend their people and fight back against Russian aggression.

"With eyes on the Middle East in recent weeks, Putin wants us to be distracted, but Ukrainians continue to fight with huge courage and nothing will distract us from continuing to stand with them for as long as it takes to secure peace."

**Windracers CEO Simon Muderack said:** "Windracers is proud to be part of this historic announcement from the UK Government, led by Defence Secretary John Healey, as one of the companies selected to provide uncrewed systems to Ukraine.

"As an independent UK-born autonomous sovereign capability, Windracers ULTRA provides Ukraine with a resilient, dual-use heavy-lift platform offering long-range operational air support."

Windracers ULTRA has been in active operation in Ukraine since 2023 and is capable of carrying more than 150kg and flying more than 2,000km.

Earlier this year, Windracers announced that Windracers ULTRA is set to deploy in Greenland, further demonstrating its ability to operate reliably in some of the world's most extreme and challenging conditions.
