

A NEW ERA FOR EODH S.A.

After 25 years of outstanding cooperation, a new milestone marks the business relationship between KNDS and EODH, with the Greek company making a dynamic entry into the land platforms manufacturing sector of the Franco-German group.

During the international EUROSATORY 2026 exhibition, a new contract between EODH and KNDS was signed in a symbolic ceremony held at the EODH stand, marking the beginning of a new strategic partnership. The first phase of this cooperation will focus on the production of the highly successful BOXER 8x8 family of land platforms.

This Executive Agreement marks the start of a new ten-year partnership between EODH and the leading European manufacturer, with a total value of approximately €200 million.

The new contract was signed on behalf of KNDS by Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Florian Hohenwarter, Senior Vice President Heinz Oestervoss, Senior Vice President Procurement Tanja Heinemann, and Head of Department / Director of Purchasing & Logistics Jörg Müller. EODH was represented by its President, Andreas Mitsis. The signing ceremony was attended by Dr. Hans Christoph Atzpodien, Director General of the German Defence Industries Association (BDSV), who emphasized the paramount importance of defence industrial cooperation among EU Member States in the fields of defence and security.

Following the signing ceremony, EODH, through its President, presented commemorative plaques to CEO Florian Hohenwarter and the distinguished KNDS executives in recognition of 25 years of excellent cooperation and mutual trust.

Subsequently, CEO Florian Hohenwarter expressed his satisfaction and appreciation for having partners such as EODH. He highlighted KNDS's confidence in EODH's ability to deliver the contracted production on time and to the highest quality standards.

Finally, EODH's President Andreas Mitsis, referring to the long-standing strategic cooperation between the two companies, thanked KNDS CEO Florian Hohenwarter and his colleagues for the tangible trust they have shown in EODH and for their mutually beneficial cooperation. He assured them that both he and his colleagues will honor the signature that seals this new endeavor and the project they have undertaken.
